LOCAL RULES--TATUM RIDGE MEN'S GOLF ASSOCIATION

March 20, 2014

- 1. NO PENALTY DROP (nearest relief, 1 club length, no nearer the hole).
 - A. Ball resting in the ditch to the right of hole 15 (including the rock area).
 - B. Ball resting in the well or touching mulch around any plant, tree, shrub and flower beds.
 - C. Ball resting in a tire track or rut in a closely mown area around a green apron. The decision in this case rests with the player whose ball is in the tire track or rut and should be guided by common sense (i.e., will the tire track or rut interfere with a normal swing?).
 - D. All staked trees, plants, flowers and tree roots lying above the ground--this includes STANCE and SWING. Note: If ball is in the bushes or stays in a tree, it is not a free drop. EXCEPTION ON FREE DROP--Bushes near the rest rooms on hole 15 and bushes near the pumps and pipes on hole 12 are not free drops.
 - E. All culverts including plants on top of any culvert, is a free drop if the ball is found. If the ball is lost, there is a 1-stroke penalty.
 - F. The ground under repair on the left side of holes 10 and 18 is a free drop, even if the ball is not found.
- All lakes are considered Lateral Water Hazards, all waste areas are considered Hazards, and this
 includes the railroad ties or rocks on Holes 3, 9, and 13. (In lieu of "red stakes", the TRMGA line
 is always 1 club length from the edge of the embankment). Precede under USGA rule 26-1
- 3. OUT OF BOUNDS:
 - A. Fences and hedges on Holes 4, 5, 16, 17 & 18. Note: Hedges and fences on 16 and 18 are not considered for a free drop.
 - B. White stakes on Hole 6. Proceed under USGA rule 27-2 (Play a provisional ball if you think your ball is out of bounds).
