

Two Teams Tie For First at the 2019 Gary Rayle Cup Tournament

The fourth annual Gary Rayle Cup tournament was held at Tatum Ridge Golf Links on Wednesday, April 3. Eleven four-man teams, drawn at random, competed for the cup. There was \$880 in prize money, and an additional \$1,040 in pari-mutuel side bets up for grabs.

Two teams tied for first with a net score of 51. Congratulations to the first place teams of Bob Cross, Tom Fields, Kelly McGee and Larry Myers; and Jeff Baumeister, Paul Butt, Ken Myers and Roy Payne. Second place was captured by the team of Sandy DiPrima, Ralph Milykovic, Rich Raymond and Don Steinwachs with a net score of 52. There was a two-way tie for third place with a net score of 53. Jeff Anderson, Bob Clarke, Lew Dingle and Lee Stephenson comprised one of the third place teams, and Steve DeWitt, Ron McGee, George Overturf and Bob Reese comprised the other.

First place paid out \$77 each in prize money, second place \$44 each, and third place \$11 each. With regard to the side bets, there were 25 shares bet on the winning teams. Each share was worth \$42. Congratulations to Ken Myers and Larry Myers who each purchased four shares on the winning squads, pocketing \$168 in the process.

The all-time lowest score for the tournament remains a net 48, which was achieved in both 2016 and 2017.
