Snowbirds Defeat the Sunbirds Again in Seventh Annual Ryder Cup

The Snowbirds found a way to win their fifth consecutive Ryder Cup tournament held at Tatum Ridge on January 13 and 15, 2020 defeating the Sunbirds by the final score of 28 to 25.
